1. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, confines his prayer to the limited extent to direct the respondent No.2 to decide the representation submitted by him with respect to illegal mining being carried out in the mountain range falling in the Village Deeppura, Todi Mod, Sikar Road, Jaipur, Rajasthan within a time bound manner.

2. Considering the limited submission so made, the writ petition stands disposed of while granting liberty to the petitioner to file a

representation before the respondent No.2 within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of this order.

3. In the event of any such representation being filed, the respondent No.2 is expected to decide the same by passing a speaking and reasoned order expeditiously, preferably within a period of 30 days thereafter.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.

5. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.

6. Needless to say, this order has been passed only to decide the petitioner's representation and in no manner is to be construed as a direction to decide the said representation in a particular manner.
