Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the year 1975, the petitioner, being a landless person, was allotted 5 bighas of land.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the said allotment was done after following due procedure and after inquiry and formation of Committee as per the relevant Land Allotment Rules.

The said contention is seriously refuted by learned counsel for the respondents. Learned counsel for the respondents has drawn attention of this court to the operative portion of the impugned Board of Revenue order dated 18.12.2008 to submit

that the basic tenet of allotment was the compulsory condition that the allottee should be a permanent resident of the State of Rajasthan. It is further contented that the present petitioner belonged to State of Haryana and, therefore, the allotment was rightly cancelled.

In the light of the said submissions, this court directs the respondent to call for the entire record of the case, especially relating to allotment which was conducted in the year 1975. Respondents are further directed to conduct an enquiry about the present status and whereabouts of the petitioner.
