1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner being aggrieved by the order dated 15.09.2025 passed by Senior Civil Judge and Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khairthal-Tijara, vide which, while allowing the application filed by the petitioner filed under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002, the petitioner has been directed to deposit the amount towards the expenses with the Police Department for execution of the said order.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the order dated 30.10.2025 passed in ***S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 14449/25*** titled as ***Tyger Home Finance Private Limited versus State of Rajasthan and Ors.***, the order dated 20.11.2025 passed at the principal seat in ***S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 22485/25***, titled as ***AU Small Finance Bank Ltd***

versus State of Rajasthan and Ors. and the order dated 03.02.2026 passed by this Court in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 1300/2026** titled as **Authum Investment and Infrastructure Limited versus State of Rajasthan and Ors.**

3. Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.
4. Notices be sent through registered post in addition to the normal process.
5. Notices be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. Ms. Sunita Meena, Advocate, and Ms. Devakriti Vashishtha, Advocate, put in appearance for Mr. Bhunesh Sharma, learned AAG, on behalf of respondent No.
7. Till further orders, respondents No.1 to 4 are directed to comply with the order dated 15.09.2025 passed by Senior Civil Judge and Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khairthal-Tijara, without raising any demand towards expenses for execution of the said order. Consequently, the demand so raised by respondent No.3 vide letter dated 20.01.2026 shall remain stayed.
8. List the matter after four weeks after showing name of Mr. Bhunesh Sharma, learned AAG, in the cause list.
