1. Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a limited prayer that the petitioner Institution has preferred an application before the respondents for the purpose of grant of NOC for B.Sc. Nursing and GNM Courses for the academic session 2025-26. He submits that till date, the respondents have not processed the application filed by the petitioner on 25.03.2025 (Annex.1). He submits that the respondents may be directed to decide the said applications in a time bound manner, as the third round of counselling would be conducted in a short time and the petitioner Institution would be deprived of running the aforesaid courses.

2. Thus, in view of the limited submissions made, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to decide the application dated 25.03.2025 filed by the petitioner – Institution (Annex.1) for the purpose of grant of NOC for the Courses B.Sc. Nursing and GNM, strictly in accordance with law after taking into consideration all the requisites required to be fulfilled by the petitioner - Institution and also by undertaking necessary inspection. Entire exercise shall be completed within 45 days from the date of receipt of the said order.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. Stay application as well as any other pending application, if any, also stand disposed of.

4. It is made clear that this order does not indicate the application of the petitioner be decided in a particular manner. The respondents are required to examine the application of the petitioner for grant of NOC in accordance with law and in view of inspection to be made by the respondent authorities within the time frame as prescribed under this order.
