Mr. Pramod Kumar Saini, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that vide the impugned order dated 27.06.2025 passed by Sub-Divisional Officer, Jhunjhunu, merely on the basis of a proposal dated 19.06.2025 issued by Tehsildar, Gudha Gorji, District Jhunjhunu (Rajasthan), with respect to khasra Nos.545, 980/548, 548, 979/548 and 557 (new khasra Nos.1305/980, 1301/557/1299/548, 1303/979 and 545) situated at Dholakheda, Patwar Mandal Raghunathpura, Tehsil Udaipurwati, District Jhunjhunu, directions have been issued to create a right of way through the khatedari land of the petitioners without issuing any notice.

Learned counsel for the for the petitioners submits that the entire exercise has been carried out by the respondents in absolutely cursory manner and that too without issuing any notice much less granting an opportunity of hearing which absolutely defeats the principles of natural justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed reliance upon the order dated 02.08.2022 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court at Principal Seat, Jodhpur in ***S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.3333/2019***, titled as ***Hari Singh and Anr. Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors.*** and the order dated 13.05.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ***S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.2002/2024***, titled as ***Sagarmal Balai Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors.***

Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents.

Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned AGC, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents.

Hence, service is complete and notice need not be filed.

Name of Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned AGC, be shown in the cause list as learned counsel for the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to serve a copy of the writ petition in the Office of Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned AGC, within three days from today.

List the matter on 16.04.2026, on or before which, learned counsel for the respondents may file reply to the writ petition.

Till the next date, the operation of the impugned order dated 27.06.2025 shall remain stayed.

However, the learned counsel for the respondents would be at liberty to file an application seeking vacation/modification of this order.
