This Court gave directions to submit compliance report department as well as the institution/ board wise so that the order passed by this Court may be implemented effectively for the public cause. Today, matter was kept to see compliance of the order by the Revenue Department as well Municipal Corporation, Jaipur.

Mr. R.P. Singh and Mrs. Sheetal Mirdha, learned Additional Advocate Generals, put in their appearance and prayed for some time to study the matter as they have recently been appointed as Additional Advocate Generals.

On the next date, compliance by Revenue Department, JMC and JDA would be looked into and, for that, let matter be listed on 30th January, 2019 enabling Additional Advocate Generals not only to see the compliance of the order of this Court but would further be expected to monitor the entire issue by not keeping it limit to Ramgarh Dam but for the entire State and it would be with co-ordination with all the departments concerned. It is whether Department of Forest, Revenue, Irrigation or PHD and, for that, even the Pollution Control Board.

The State Government would be expected to come out with a proper decision and implementation of the order so that all reservoirs in the State of Rajasthan with catchment areas are

saved and at the same time to see ground water free from pollution.

Learned Additional Advocate Generals Mr. R.P. Singh and Mrs. Sheetal Mirdha would look into all the aspects of the matter and co-ordinate with the Monitoring Committee apart from officer of concerned departments.

Mr. Akhil Simlote is appearing for the Pollution Control Board but we direct Mr. R.D. Rastogi, Advocate to appear for Pollution Control Board and, accordingly, Pollution Control Board is directed to furnish compliance report through learned Senior counsel Mr. R.D. Rastogi, who was earlier appearing for the Board. He would assist the Court.
