Shri R.P. Singh, learned Additional Advocate General submits that he has filed a compliance report today. He shall also file Minutes of the meeting convened by the Nodel officer/Coordinator Shri Rohit Kumar Singh, Additional Chief Secretary appointed for implementation of different orders passed by this Court in the

present matter and related subjects, to coordinate between various departments of the State of Rajasthan.

Shri Virendra Dangi and Shri Ashok Kumar Bhargava, learned counsels submitted that they received copy of the compliance report only this morning and want to study the same and file their response.

In the meantime, the respondents as per their submissions in para 3(A) of the compliance report, may approach the Central Road Reserve Institute (CRRRI) for their opinion as to how the silt accumulated in the river bed of Banganga, Modhovani and Gomti Ka Nala can be removed and how best it can be utilised.

Further, the respondent-State in terms of what has been stated in para 4 of the compliance report, ensure distribution of 100 plants/sapplings to each Gram Panchayat for their plantation before the onset of monsoon and for the time being, entrust responsibility of their watering and protection to Gram Sevak and Patwari concerned under the supervision of BDO.

Ms. Sheetal Mirdha, learned Additional Advocate General submits that she has also filed compliance report pursuant to order of this Court dated 27th March, 2019 with which she has produced the revenue map as well as superimposed map prepared on the basis of revenue map with copy to Shri Bipin Gupta, learned counsel for the respondent.

Ms. Sheetal Mirdha, learned Additional Advocate General shall provide copy thereof to each of the learned counsel for different applicants in the course of the day, who may study and file their response.

List the matter on 30th July, 2019.
