1. Mr. Manik Kaswan, Adv. & Mr. S. M. Sharma, Adv. for Mr. Manoj Sharma, AAG appears on behalf of the respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the appeal filed by the petitioner against transfer order dated 10.01.2026, has been disposed of by the Rajasthan Civil Services Appellate Tribunal vide order dated 18.02.2026, directing the

petitioner to make a representation before the competent authority describing his difficulties and objections against the transfer order, and the petitioner is also ready to make a representation, however, hardship of the petitioner has not been properly considered by the Tribunal and the petitioner has been transferred in mid-session.

3. In the light of above, this writ petition is disposed of and in case, any representation is submitted by the petitioner against transfer order dated 10.01.2026, the competent authority shall decide the same in accordance with law by speaking order.

4. However, even if the representation is decided against the petitioner, looking to the schedule of examinations the petitioner shall not be relieved from the present place of posting till 31st of March, 2026 and if relieved even then shall be allowed to continue his work at present place of posting till the above date.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stand(s), disposed of.
