1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Cr.P.C seeking quashing of the FIR No.686/2018 registered at Police Station Kanota, Jaipur City (East) for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 425, 442, 463, 464, 120-B and 34 of I.P.C.
2. Vide order dated 27.02.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, it was ordered that further proceedings arising out of the impugned FIR shall remain stayed.

3. In that view of the matter, the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer and shall join the investigation. The Investigating Officer is directed to furnish his report on or before the next date of hearing.

4. List the matter after three weeks.

5. However, till the next date of hearing, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.686/2018 registered at Police Station Kanota, Jaipur City (East).
