1. The instant second bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-applicant. The accused-applicant was arrested in connection with FIR No. 146/2025 registered at Police Station Raisar District Jaipur for the offence(s) under Sections 189(2), 115(2), 126(2), 329(4), 324(4), 74 of BNS, 2023 and the learned Trial Court amidst the offences under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 352, 109(1), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 dismissed the bail application before it.

2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant has submitted that the applicant is 46 years of age; and co-accused Mahesh Kumar was granted bail by this Court on 10.11.2025. It is submitted that the applicant is behind custody ever-since 06.10.2025; and that charge-sheet has been filed in the instant matter. It is submitted that the statement of material witnesses

have been recorded and there is a deviation in the contents of the report and the statements. It is submitted that there is one antecedent registered against the applicant.

3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor has stoutly opposed the instant second bail application.

4. Heard and considered.

5. Considering the overall facts of the case and taking note of the fact that the applicant is aged about 46 years; that the co-accused Mahesh Kumar was granted bail by this Court on 10.11.2025; that the applicant is behind custody ever-since 06.10.2025; that charge-sheet has already been filed; that there are contradictory statements by the material witnesses; but without commenting upon the merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the accused-applicant on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is **allowed** and it is ordered that accused-applicant **Lalluram Meena S/o Nehnuram Meena** shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
