The matter comes up on an application (IA No.1/2025)
filed by the respondent University of Rajasthan for vacating the

ex-parte interim order dated 04.03.2025 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

The learned counsel for the respondent- University of Rajasthan submits that in notification dated 15.12.2023, Clause 6 and in the resolution of Board Of Inspection taken in its meeting dated 07.10.2014 as regards the Clause 18, provides for charging inspection/re-inspection fees before granting provisional affiliation or extension of the affiliation of the courses.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that there is no provision in the notification and in any other law for charging the inspection fees.

Taking into consideration the overall facts and circumstances of the case, this Court prima facie is of the opinion that whenever the affiliation is granted or any provisional affiliation is extended, the respondent University can make a demand for the inspection/re-inspection fees.

The learned counsel for the petitioner also submitted that till date no any demand of inspection fees has been made by the University of Rajasthan from the members of the petitioner Sangh for depositing any inspection fees.

In view of the above, the Court deems just and proper to vacate the interim order dated 04.03.2025 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

However, it is made clear that any inspection/ re-inspection fees deposited by the petitioner on being demanded by the respondent, shall remain subject to final out come of this petition.

Accordingly, application (IA No.1/2025) is allowed.
