Learned counsel for the respondents at the outset raised an objection that the present writ petition although, ostensibly appears to have been filed by the Managing Committee Shri Raghunath Higher Secondary School, Laxmangarh (Sikar) yet, as per the provisions of Rajasthan Non-Government Educational Institution Act, 1989 and Rules 1993 made thereunder, only the Secretary can initiate any legal proceedings. He submits this writ petition supported by an affidavit swearing by **Mr. Poonam Chand Joshi**, however, in the entire writ petition, the competence and locus of Mr. Poonam Chand Joshi so as to

enable him to file the instant writ petitions has not been pleaded. Learned counsel for the respondents also submits that no documents whatsoever has been enclosed along with writ petition, so as to show that Mr. Poonam Chand Joshi is either office bearer of the Managing Committee or is holding any post in any manner whatsoever nor there are pleadings to this fact therefore, only on this ground, as the writ petition has been filed without there being any lawful authority, same should be dismissed at the threshold.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks time to address the aforesaid issue.

List this matter on 4th March, 2026.

Till then, interim order, if any, shall continue.
