**(S.B. Civil Miscellaneous Appeal No. 1318/2025)**

1. The matter comes upon an application bearing S.B. Civil Misc. Application No. 562/2025 filed by the appellant under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay in filing of the appeal.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the applicant/appellant submits that delay in filing the appeal is neither mala fide nor deliberate. He also submits that other two appeals, one of the Insurance Company and other one by claimants, is already pending before this Court and no prejudice would be caused to any of the party by condoning the delay in filing the appeal as the matter has to be heard on merit in the connected appeals also.
3. Having regard to the submissions made by the counsel for the appellant, the Court deems just and proper to condon the delay in filing the appeal.
4. Accordingly, application bearing S.B. Civil Misc. Application No. 562/2025 filed by the appellant under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, is allowed. Delay in filing the appeal is condoned.
5. Issue notice to the respondents.
