Instant Criminal Misc. Application under Section 528 of BNSS
has been filed on behalf of respondent No.4, who is father of

petitioner No.1, to recall the order dated 22.01.2026 passed by this Court in SB Cr. Writ Petition No.118/2006.

By the order dated 22.01.2026, this Court while disposing of the petition, simply observed that the petitioners are free to file appropriate application seeking protection before the concerned SHO and concerned SHO was also directed to ensure that no physical harm is caused to the petitioners.

With regard to the validity of marriage of the petitioners and documents annexed with the petition, this Court did not express any opinion in the order dated 22.01.2026 and it was also made clear that protection order will not affect any civil/criminal proceedings, if any, in the present matter.

In view of above, this Court does not find any good ground to recall the order dated 22.01.2026.

Accordingly, this Criminal Misc. Application is dismissed.
