While impugning the judgment and decree dated 27.01.2026 passed by the learned District & Sessions Judge, Deeg (Rajasthan), in Civil Appeal No. 07/2026 (CIS No.13/2019), titled as '*Shyam Singh Vs. Shri Mahendra & Ors.*', whereby the appeal filed by the respondent/plaintiffs was partly allowed, and the judgment and decree dated 07.08.2019 passed by the learned Senior Civil Judge, Deeg, District Bharatpur, in Civil Suit No.08/2015 (CIS No.05/16), titled as '*Shyam Singh Vs. Mahendra & Ors.*', was set aside; learned counsel for the appellants submits that substantial questions of law are involved in the present second appeal. He therefore prays that the impugned judgment and decree dated 27.01.2026 is unsustainable in the eye of law.

2. Heard.

3. In view of the submissions made hereinabove, issue notice to the respondent, returnable on 02.04.2026.

4. Notices be filed in two sets. Upon filing the same, one set be sent by ordinary post and another by registered post.
