Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5.

Let notice be issued to respondent Nos.6 to 9 through both the process. Rule is made returnable within a period of six weeks.

Meanwhile, petitioners are free to file appropriate application seeking protection before respondent No.5 - SHO, Police Station Nainwa, District Bundi (Raj).

If any such application is filed by petitioners, respondent No.5 is directed to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.
