1. It is stated that an ex-parte decree was passed on 20.12.2024 and execution proceedings were initiated and order of attachment was passed on 23.01.2026 for satisfaction of the decree amount of Rs.96,27,826.04. Learned counsel submits that an application under Order IX Rule 13 CPC has been moved for setting aside the ex-parte decree passed by the Commercial Court. Learned counsel further submits till the application is decided the attachment order may be stayed. Learned counsel

also states that the defects pointed out by the Registry have already been meted out.

2. Delay in filing the appeal is condoned and the application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act is allowed.

3. Issue notice.

4. In the meanwhile the attachment proceedings dated 23.01.2026 shall remain stayed. However, the interim order passed by us shall not prevent the concerned Commercial Court to pass orders on merits on application under Order IX Rule 13 CPC.

5. It is made clear that interim order shall operate only till the disposal of the application under Order IX Rule 13 CPC.

6. List this case again after six weeks.
