1. The present civil first appeal has been filed by the appellants against the judgment and decree dated 18.11.2025 passed by learned Additional District Judge No.4, Kotputli-Behror (hereinafter referred to as the learned 'trial Court') in Fatal Accident Claim No.27/2022, whereby, the suit filed on behalf of the respondents-claimants claiming compensation for the death of Subhash due to electrocution, has been decreed and an award of Rs.14,52,574/-

along with interest @ 6% per annum was awarded in favour of respondents-claimants.

2. Heard on Stay Application No.1465/2026.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants submits that the effect and operation of the judgment and decree dated 18.11.2025 passed by learned trial Court may be stayed, till the pendency of the appeal.

4. The matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice to the respondents by both modes i.e. by ordinary course as well as by registered post, returnable after six weeks. Requisites be filed within a period of one week.

6. The appellants are directed to deposit 50% of the award amount along with the interest granted in favour of the respondents vide impugned judgment and decree dated 18.11.2025 in Fatal Accident Claim No.27/2022 with Additional District Judge No.4, Kotputli-Behror within a period of one month from today.

7. On depositing the said amount by the appellants, the same shall be disbursed amongst the respondents-claimants in terms of the impugned award dated 18.11.2025, on an undertaking by the respondents-claimants that in case, appeal of appellants succeeds, the respondents-claimants shall repay the amount, so received, along with interest @ 6% per annum.

8. If the aforesaid amount is deposited by the appellants within the stipulated period, then the effect and operation of the impugned judgment and decree dated 18.11.2025 shall remain stayed, till further orders of this Court.

9. List the matter after six weeks.



10. In the meanwhile, record of the Court below be summoned.
