Heard on the application for condonation of delay which occurred in filing the restoration application.

Considered the submissions.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant-appellant and for the reasons mentioned in the application, the Court deems just and proper to condone the delay.

Accordingly, the application for condonation of delay is allowed and the delay of 486 days which occurred in filing the restoration application, is condoned.

Application No. CMCC 883/2026 stands disposed off.

The restoration application has been filed by the applicant-appellant for restoration of S.B. Civil Misc. Appeal No. 297/2019 to its original number, which was dismissed vide order dated 07.10.2023 in pursuance to peremptory order dated 29.08.2023.

Considered the submissions.

Having regard to the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant-appellant and for the reasons mentioned in the restoration application, this Court deems just and proper to allow the restoration application and restore the case to its original number.

Accordingly, the restoration application is allowed subject to payment of cost of Rs.2,000/-, to be deposited with the Rajasthan High Court Bar Association, Jaipur Bench, Jaipur.

On submission the receipt of deposited amount by the counsel for the applicant-appellant with the Registry, the S.B. Civil Misc. Appeal No. 297/2019 be restored to its original number.
