This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with the
following prayer:-

"It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed
that the Hon'ble High Court may call for the
entire record of the case and after examining
the same be pleased to issue appropriate
writ, order or direction.

(i) To the respondents to
release/pay/grant additional increment on
completion of six years as Assistant Manager
(Account) w.e.f. 30.11.2001 and wage
revision benefits may also be granted
alongwith all consequential benefits with
interest at the rat of 18% per annum till the
date of actual payment.

(ii) Any other prejudicial order or direction,
if passed during the pendency of writ

petition, may kindly be taken on record and after examining the same be queashed and set aside.

(iii) Any other order or direction, which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper, may also be passed in favour of the petitioner.

(iv) Costs be quantified in favour of the petitioner.

As per affidavit submitted by the petitioner alongwith the writ petition, he was 55 years old at the time of filing of the writ petition in the year 2002.

In my considered view, as of now, the petitioner has retired from service after attaining the age of superannuation, therefore, by efflux of time, the present writ petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of as having become infructuous.
