The present writ petition has been filed challenging the order dated 05.02.2026 passed by the learned Board of Revenue, Ajmer (**BOR**) in Appeal Decree/T.A./1123/2008/Baran, vide which the

judgment and decree dated 28.01.2008 passed by the Revenue Appellate Authority, Kota in Appeal No. 446/2007, and also the judgment and preliminary decree dated 14.06.2007 passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Chhabra in Revenue Suit No. 140/2000 have been set aside and the counter-claim filed by respondent No.1-Jamna Bai, has been allowed.

Mr. Ripunjay Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there was no occasion for the learned BOR to interfere with the concurrent findings recorded by both the lower authorities.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the will was duly executed and despite the respondents having miserably failed to dispute its validity, the impugned order has been passed.

Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents, returnable within six weeks, both by ordinary process as well as the registered post.

Notices be given *dasti* as well to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

List the matter on 19.05.2026.

Till the next date, the effect and operation of the order dated 05.02.2026 (Annexure 1) passed by the learned BOR shall remain stayed.
