The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the order dated 27.11.2025 passed by the learned Board of Revenue, Rajasthan, Ajmer in Appeal/T.A./286/2022/Jaipur, titled as Jobner Gramin Bahu Uddeshiya Sahkari Samiti Ltd. Vs. Kailash and Ors., which was filed against the order dated 13.01.2022 passed by the learned Revenue Appellate Authority, Jaipur, whereby the Review Petition filed by the respondent No.1 was dismissed.

By the impugned order dated 27.11.2025, the learned Board of Revenue has not only granted liberty to the respondent No.1 to withdraw the appeal filed by it but has also granted specific permission to respondent No.1 to challenge the original order dated 30.04.2002 passed by the learned Revenue Appellate Authority, by filing an appeal before the learned Board of Revenue in view of the order dated 28.08.2025 passed by a larger Bench of the learned Board of Revenue in case No.511/2023.

Mr. Himanshu Sogani, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the learned Board of Revenue has travelled beyond

its jurisdiction by granting a permission to the respondent No.1 to file an appeal against the order dated 30.04.2002.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the respondent No.1 itself chose to challenge the order dated 30.04.2002 by filing a Review Petition, whereas the liberty to challenge the order dated 30.04.2002 by filing an appeal before the learned Board of Revenue was always available to it even at that time. Thus, under the guise of the order dated 28.08.2025 and so also the permission granted to it vide order dated 27.11.2025, it cannot seek to cover up the time which has lapsed after the passing of the order dated 30.04.2002.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the writ petition challenging the order dated 28.08.2025 has already been filed by him before this Court bearing S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.20693/2025.

Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents, returnable within six weeks. Notice be sent through registered post in addition to normal process.

In the meanwhile, the effect and operation of the order dated 27.11.2025 shall remain stayed to the extent it grants permission to respondent No.1 to file an appeal against the order dated 30.04.2002 passed by the learned Revenue Appellate Authority.

List the matter along with S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.20693/2025 on 05.05.2026.
