Order

1. Matter comes up on compromise submitted by the parties with a prayer to decide the instant appeal in light of the terms and conditions of the compromise.
2. Counsels for the parties submit that the parties have settled their dispute by entering into a compromise and it has been agreed that the insurance company would pay a lump sum amount of Rs.2,00,000/- to the claimant, in addition to the amount already awarded by the Motor Accident Claims

Tribunal (for short, 'the Tribunal'). It has also been agreed between the parties that the above additional amount would be deposited by the insurance company within a period of six weeks from the date of filing the compromise before this Court and in case, the aforesaid amount is not deposited within the above stipulated time, the aforesaid amount shall carry interest @6% from the date of compromise till its actual payment.

3. Considering the above factual aspect of the matter, the instant civil misc. appeal stands disposed of in terms of the compromise arrived between the parties.

4. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
