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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE PRAVEER BHATNAGAR**

**Order**

**21/04/2026**

1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioner. The accused-petitioner has been arrested in connection with FIR No.589/2024, registered at Police Station Aravalli Vihar, District Alwar for the offence(s) under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B of IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. It is contended that there was a money dispute between the parties and the petitioner has falsely been alleged to have demanded money on the pretext of granting employment to the complainant's two sons. It is also contended that during the course of investigation, the complainant has submitted the

compromise entered into with the petitioner. It is argued that the accused-petitioner is in custody since long, the matter is exclusively triable by the Magistrate and the trial of the case may take considerable time, therefore, the bail application of the accused-petitioner may be allowed.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted the factual report, the same is taken on record.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. It has come on record that the complainant Vimal Singh submitted a compromise on 09.03.2026 asserting the fact that both the parties have entered into a compromise and the petitioner has returned the amount to the complainant, therefore, considering the aforesaid facts, without further going into the merits of this case, this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner- **Satyendra Kumar Gangawat Alias Dr. Naresh Gangawat S/o Shri Naval Kishore Gangawat**, in connection with FIR No.589/2024, registered at Police Station Aravalli Vihar, District Alwar, shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
