Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present case reveals a precarious circumstance wherein one Mr. Sunil on 11.03.2026 had purchased jewellery amounting to Rs.2,74,618/- from M/s DLG Jewellers, which is a proprietorship firm of which the petitioner is the proprietor. The payment of the said amount was made through the bank account of Mr. Sunil, however, immediately thereafter, an alleged complaint was made by the said purchaser with respect to a fraud being committed upon him of the equivalent amount i.e., Rs.2,74,618/-, which was registered on complaint number 1930. Acting on the said complaint, the said amount was put on hold in the bank account of the firm, however, no information with respect to the said action was communicated to the petitioner.

Thereafter, upon obtaining knowledge of the said hold being placed on the bank account of the petitioner, the petitioner approached the concerned branch of respondent No.2 - Bank,

from where she came to know about the alleged fraud being committed against her by the said purchaser/complainant – Mr. Sunil.

Thereafter, a complaint has also been filed by the petitioner on the cyber crime portal.

Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents.

Mr. Munendra Singh, appearing for Mr. Somitra Chaturvedi, learned Dy. G.C., accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 3.

Hence, service is complete *qua* the aforementioned respondents and notice be filed for respondent No.2. Notice be sent through registered post in addition to normal process.

List the matter in the category “for fresh admission” on 20.04.2026, on or before which, learned counsel for the respondents may file reply to the writ petition.

Till the next date, the respondents are directed to not to transfer or release the amount of Rs.2,74,618/- from the bank account of the petitioner maintained with respondent No.2 – Bank.
