Instant Criminal Misc. Application under Section 528 of BNSS has been filed on behalf of applicant/respondent No.7-Sittara, who



is mother of petitioner No.1, with the prayer that necessary directions may be issued for initiating criminal proceedings against the petitioners for producing forged/false birth certificate of petitioner No.1 before this Court for obtaining the protection order dated 19.12.2025 passed in SB Cr. Writ Petition No.1672/2025.

Vide order dated 19.12.2025, this Court while disposing of the writ petition No.1672/2025, simply observed that the petitioners are free to file appropriate application seeking protection before the concerned SHO and concerned SHO was also directed to ensure that no physical harm is caused to the petitioners.

With regard to the age of the petitioner No.1 and documents annexed with the petition, this Court did not express any opinion in the order dated 19.12.2025 and it was also made clear that protection order will not affect any civil/criminal proceedings, if any, in the present matter.

If the applicant/respondent No.7 is having any grievance about the production of false/forged documents regarding the age of petitioner No.1, she can avail appropriate remedy available in law.

In view of above, this Court does not find it appropriate to issue direction for initiating criminal proceedings against the petitioners for producing forged documents before this Court while obtaining the order of protection dated 19.12.2025.

Accordingly, this Criminal Misc. Application is dismissed.
