The present writ petition has been filed challenging the order dated 02.02.2026 (Annexure-9) issued by the Assistant Mining Engineer, Tonk, vide which a demand of Rs.46,25,900/- has been determined against the petitioner on account of illegal excavation of minerals.

Mr. Himanshu Choudhary, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a show cause notice dated 07.01.2026 (Annexure-7) was issued by the respondent – Department of Mines and Geology,

Tonk, alleging excavation of minerals from Gair Mumkin Talab situated at Khasra No.94, Village Sangrampura, Tehsil Niwai, District Tonk. In response thereto, vide reply dated 20.01.2026 it was submitted by the petitioner that the entire excavation work was carried out in pursuance of the Amrit Sarovar Yojana and that the petitioner was issued a work order pursuant to the LOA dated 04.11.2024 and thus, there was no occasion for issuing the impugned show cause notice dated 07.01.2026 (Annexure-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that despite each and every aspect having been dealt with and documents having been annexed with the reply, none of the same have been considered and vide impugned order dated 02.02.2026 (Annexure-9), a demand of Rs.46,25,900/- has been imposed upon the petitioner.

Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents No. 1 to 4, returnable by 08.04.2026, both by ordinary process as well as the registered post.

Notices be given *dasti* as well to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Mr. Rahul Lodha, learned AGC, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 to 3.

Hence service *qua* respondents No.1 to 3 stands complete. Notice be filed only for respondent No.4.

In the meanwhile and till further orders, the effect and operation of the demand order dated 02.02.2026 (Annexure-9) shall remain stayed.
