1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that according to the minutes of meeting, it appears that respondents are facing shortage of EDC (Eco-Development and Conservation) guide in Zone Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 in Ranthambore Tiger Project, Sawai Madhopur. Counsel submits that petitioner is a member of EDC. Counsel submits that now, two months' training for EDC guide is scheduled from 01.05.2025 but petitioner has not been selected for training despite the fact that petitioner is a member of EDC.
2. In view of above submissions, issue notice of this writ petition as well as stay application to respondent Nos.1 to 4, through both the process, returnable on next date of hearing.

Requisites be filed within a period of one week, failing which, this petition shall stand dismissed without any further reference to the bench.

3. If requisites are filed within given time, list this matter after six weeks.

4. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, especially the fact that petitioner is a member of EDC which is evident from Annexure-2, as an interim measure, respondents are directed to provide training of EDC guide to the petitioner on provisional basis.

5. It is made clear that no equity would rise in favour of the petitioner only on the strength of this interim order.
