1. This appeal has been filed by and on behalf of Jaipur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, assailing the final award and judgment dated 26.02.2026 passed by the Court of Employees

Compensation Commissioner, Dausa, directing the appellants to pay compensation to the tune of Rs.9,79,480/- along with interest @ 12% p.a. w.e.f. 05.05.2014. That apart, 50% penalty of the compensation amount and Rs.50,000/- against litigation expenses have also been awarded.

2. Counsel for appellants states that the compensation amount along with interest totalling Rs.23,91,541/- has already been deposited before the Court of concerned Commissioner.

3. Let notice of appeal and stay application be issued to the respondents.

4. On behalf of respondent-claimant No.1 counsel has put in appearance. Let notice be issued to remaining respondents.

5. As an interim measure, it is hereby directed that a lump sum amount of Rs.12,00,000/- out of total compensation amount, so deposited by the appellants, be disbursed to the respondent no.1-claimant in his bank account so furnished by him. Remaining amount of compensation shall be kept in FDR before the nationalized bank for a period, which may carry maximum interest and disbursement of same shall remain subject to orders passed finally in the present appeal.

Employee's Compensation Commissioner shall send the record, after disbursement of the compensation amount to claimant and deposition of the amount deposited by the JVVNL in FDR.
