No one has marked presence on behalf of the petitioner(s).

Keeping in view the contents of Annexure-5 i.e. prescription dated 20.12.2025, learned *amici curiae* upon marking presence in the Court have submitted that document which is undersigned by the concerned Doctor is not done in as rightful practice and an enquiry should be initiated against him. It is submitted that the opinions especially the expert opinions are ought to be given after assiduously examining the relevant material; however, the relevant document herein is a piece of paper sans any knowledge and requisite analysis.

Heard.

Inspite of categoric directions, author/undersigning authority of the Annexure-5 has not marked presence in the Court.

This Court directs the respondent-Union of India and State of Rajasthan to ensure service upon the concerned authority at Rajkiya Shri Kalyan Chikitsalaya, Sikar.

Concerned Jurisdictional Police Station SHO, is also directed to communicate the same to the author/undersigning authority of Annexure-5 to ensure his presence in the Court on the next date of hearing, failing which this Court might be compelled to issue non-bailable warrants against the concerned authority.

*Amici curiae* are directed to remain present in the Court on the next date of hearing through VC or in person.

In the interest of justice, time is granted to the petitioner to argue the matter.

It is made clear that if on the next date of hearing, no one marks presence on behalf of the petitioner, present matter will be decided on its own merits.
