Matters have come up on the board for orders on the second stay applications filed by the petitioners with the prayer that the respondent no.4, namely, the Rajasthan Urja Vikas Nigam Limited be directed to execute an extended PPA in favour of the

petitioners and be further directed it to make payment of the outstanding energy charges since October, 2018 upto date along with interest at the rate of 1.25% per month on daily basis and accept subsequent invoices from April, 2019 onwards.

On hearing learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant, learned Advocate General, learned counsel for the respondent Nos. 1 to 4, this court is not inclined to grant prayer made in the second stay applications as that would tantamount to granting final relief at the interlocutory stage. In the opinion of the court, these matters are such which need to be heard and decided finally early at admission stage. Therefore, we direct that these matters may be listed for final disposal at admission stage on 16.10.2019 along with D.B. Civil Writ Petition Nos. 15097/2019, 15139/2019 and 16152/2019.

Learned counsel for the parties may submit their written submissions in advance, running into not more than ten pages, accompanied by case laws on which they seek to rely.
