Mr. Jai Lodha, learned counsel appears on behalf of respondent No.3-Jodhpur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd. and submits that he has not received copy of memo of writ petitions.

Learned counsel for the petitioners shall supply copy of writ petitions to Mr. Jai Lodha, learned counsel for the respondent No.3 by tomorrow and his name be shown in the cause list.

Learned counsel for the parties have agreed that DB Civil Writ Petition Nos.5997/2019 & 17430/2019 may be treated as leading case in the present batch of writ petitions and the respondents in both the aforesaid writ petitions may file their reply.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that they shall file reply in aforesaid two writ petitions and adopt the same in other writ petitions. They shall also supply copy of the reply to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Mr. Ravi Chirania, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the DB CWP Nos. 53446/2019, 17482/2019, 17028/2019, 17027/2019 & 17484/2019 be clubbed with this batch of writ petitions.

Mr. M.S. Singhvi, learned Advocate General submits that some of the parties have filed writ petitions before the Single Bench without challenging the Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Energy Certificate and Renewable Purchase Obligation Compliance Framework) (Third Amendment) Regulations, 2019 but the issues raised in those writ petitions are incidental to the issues that are raised in the writ petitions filed before the Division Bench. He, therefore, submits that the writ petitions filed before the Single Bench may also be clubbed with the present batch of writ petitions.

Learned Advocate General may file particulars of writ petitions filed before Single Bench in the office and thereupon those writ petitions may also be listed along with these writ petitions.

Office is directed to list these writ petitions along with DB CWP Nos. 53446/2019, 17482/2019, 17028/2019, 17027/2019 & 17484/2019 on 22.10.2019.
