1. This instant bail application has been filed by the petitioner Rahul Meena S/o Shri Battilal, under Section 483 BNSS who was arrested by the police in connection with the FIR No. 95/2025 dated 15.04.2025 registered at Police Station Roopbas, District Bharatpur for the offences punishable under Sections 61(2), 189(2), 126(2), 318(4) and 351(2) of the BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that police, after conducting the investigation, has filed the charge-sheet and no further recovery and interrogation is required to be made from him. He further submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since long and the trial will take a sufficiently long time to conclude. In view thereof, he prays that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail by this Court.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor strongly opposes the bail application.
4. Heard learned counsel for both the parties.
5. The contents of the FIR shows that the petitioner and the other persons have taken money from the complainant on account of providing the employment in Govt. department. This Court notes that the allegations as noted in the FIR appears to be serious in nature.
6. Considering the contentions raised by the learned Public Prosecutor as well as counsel for the complainant, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the present petitioner on bail.
7. Accordingly, the instant bail application filed under Section 483 BNSS is dismissed.
