1. Heard on the interim stay application.
2. The present writ petition has been filed challenging the order of the learned Labour Court dated 12.03.2025 (Annex.4) whereby the learned Labour Court has determined the liability of the employer towards the employee. Assailing the same, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and having gone through the impugned order passed by the learned Labour Court dated 12.03.2025, this Court feels that the present writ petition requires hearing.
4. In the said circumstances, there shall be a stay on the execution of the order impugned dated 12.03.2025 (Annex.4) subject to the petitioner depositing 50% of the due amount determined by the learned Labour Court within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
5. If the amount is not deposited within the said period, the interim order granted shall stand automatically vacated.
6. On deposit of the aforesaid amount, the workman is permitted to withdraw the amount subject to his furnishing an undertaking, in the event, writ petition is allowed, he will refund back the said amount.
7. Admit.
8. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.
9. Post the matter on **11.05.2026**.
