In D.B. Civil Contempt Petition No. 383/2023

By way of this contempt petition, the petitioner is alleging that the interim maintenance amount as also the litigation expenses have not been paid by the respondent pursuant to the directions given by this Court on 10.01.2023.

Learned counsel Mr. Harendra Singh appearing on behalf of the respondent has submitted that the respondent is ready to pay the due maintenance amount to the petitioner. It is also submitted that earlier Rs.50,000/- and Rs.21,000/- have already been transferred in the bank account of the petitioner and today, the respondent is giving a cheque of Rs.3,64,000/- against the due maintenance amount to the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent has further submitted that though Rs.50,000/- are in receipt of the petitioner, however, Rs.21,000/- has never been received by her.

Be that as it may, learned counsel for the respondent Mr. Harendra Singh is directed to hand over cheque of Rs.3,64,000/- to counsel for the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. Tanmay Dhand shall give receipt of the same to Mr. Harendra Singh, counsel for the respondent during the course of the day. The respondent is also free to transfer the amount of Rs.3,64,000/- to the petitioner through online mode such as RTGS etc. In case the respondent transfer the amount of Rs.3,64,000/- in the account of petitioner, the counsel for the petitioner may return the cheque of Rs.3,64,000/- to the counsel for the respondent.

In view of the fact that the amount of Rs.50,000/- has already been paid to the petitioner by the respondent and cheque of Rs.3,64,000/- has also been handed over to counsel for the petitioner, this contempt petition is disposed of.

Notice is discharged.
