**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE MUNNURI LAXMAN**

**Order**

1. Heard on the interim stay application.
2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that  
the petitioner was initially appointed through an outsourcing  
agency and subsequently, he also continued to work with a newly  
selected outsourcing agency and now a third outsourcing agency  
has been selected by the employer to supply manpower. The

petitioner though was allowed to work with the two outsourcing agencies but the third outsourcing agency has not allowed the petitioner to work with the respondents. It is also submitted that services of the petitioner was likely to be not taken by the third outsourcing agency and they are trying to recruit other persons in place of the petitioner.

4. In view of the continuous working of the petitioner with the previous two outsourcing agencies, now the petitioner's services are sought to be dispensed with the third outsourcing agency and his services are sought to be replaced by another set of new persons even though he was continued to work with previous two outsourcing agencies. The respondents have selected third outsourcing agency for supply of manpower.

5. In the said circumstances, the respondents are directed to continue the services of the petitioner even if a new third outsourcing agency has been selected by them for supply of manpower.

6. Admit. Issue notice, returnable within a period of four weeks.

7. List the matter on **11.05.2026**.
