1. Compliance report filed by the respondent-State is taken on record. Learned Amicus Curiae may file her response thereto.

2. Further compliance report has been filed on behalf of the Member-Secretary, Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority. Mr. R.P. Singh, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State submits that he has not received a copy thereof. The Member-Secretary, Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority shall provide a copy thereof to Mr. R. P. Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, who prays for time to respond to the same.

3. The respondent-State may file its response to the compliance report filed by the Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority, in the context of the order passed by this Court on 09.08.2019, on following three issues:-

(i) What steps it intends to take to provide toilets and urinals in proportion of the boys, girls and the teaching staff in the Government schools as per ratio given in **Water Sanitation Hygiene (WASH) norms** according to guidelines of Government of India issued under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, which are as under:-

“No. of Toilets/Urinal (Per) No.

1 Toilet	40 Girls	and	1 Toilet	80 Boys
1 Urinal	20 Girls	and	1 Urinal	20 Boys”

(ii) What action plan has been prepared to ensure electrification of the 25,674 schools, by the Government on its own or with the aid of the Corporates out of the funds under Corporate Social Responsibility.

(iii) What is the stand of the government for installation of sanitary napkin vending machines as per the suggestion given by the Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority, at least in such government schools and colleges of the State, which have more than hundred girls students.
