On 15.11.2019, this Court passed following order.

"Learned Additional Solicitor General seeks some further time to obtain instructions on the issue of making sanitary napkins available to all the schools in Rajasthan under the various schemes that have been contemplated by the Petroleum Ministry. He may ascertain as to whether benefit of such scheme can be extended to schools and college students in the State of Rajasthan and if so in what manner. Learned counsel appearing for the State seeks some further time to file affidavit pertaining to the report submitted by RALSA about electrification of schools where no electric connection exist as on date and also pertaining to toilets available for both

the boys as well as girls in the colleges and schools inspected by RALSA. Apart from toilets, the affidavit shall also contain status of availability of fresh and pure drinking water for the students of schools and colleges."

Learned Additional Advocate General seeks four weeks' time to procure status report with regard to compliance of order dated 15.11.2019.
