Present bail cancellation application has been moved on behalf of the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence, challenging the order dated 03.02.2025, whereby concession of bail has been granted to the respondent.

Upon perusal of the material available on record, it has been observed that the present application has been moved after a lapse of approximately one and a half month from date of the impugned order and that the defects have been cured after a period of approximately six months thereafter, on 10.10.2025.

Consecutively, today, after a lapse of more than one year from date of the impugned order, the present application is listed before this Court. The said conduct of the applicant reflects sorry state of affairs as the significance of the bail cancellation application becomes irrelevant with passage of time over and about one year.

In light of the above observations, the concerned In-charge/officer of the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence to remain personally present in Court on the next date of hearing to tender justifiable explanation as to why the present application has been listed before this Court after a delay of more than one year from the date of impugned order.
