Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all available grounds taken in this petition at the stage of framing of charge. Simultaneously, he prays that the warrant of arrest issued against the petition may be converted into a bailable warrant.

Learned State Counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant opposes the prayer for conversion of the warrant of arrest into a bailable warrant.

Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that a negative final report was submitted by the Investigating Agency and cognizance has been taken on the protest petition filed by the complainant, I deem it just and proper to direct the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court on



or before 24.07.2026 and furnish his bail bonds. Learned trial Court is directed to accept the same.

Accordingly, this criminal misc. petition is dismissed to the extent of challenging the cognizance order, which has been affirmed by the revisional Court.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to raise all available grounds before the learned trial Court at the stage of consideration of charge.

Needless to say, the learned trial Court shall consider all the submissions advanced on behalf of the petitioner and pass a reasoned order in accordance with law.
