1. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the respondent-Municipal Corporation has not earmarked the vending zone inspite of directions of the Court passed on 31.08.2017 in S.B. Contempt Petition No. 1118/2017. It is also contended that the members of the petitioner-Association had applied for vending licenses, but the same has not been issued as vending zones have not been determined so far. Out of 86 vending zones, only 13 vending zones have been earmarked till date.

2. Issue notice.

3. Mr. G.S. Gill, learned Additional Advocate General has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos. 1, 3, 5, 6 & 7.

4. Mr. Basant Singh Chhaba, learned Additional Advocate General has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 & 4.

5. Time is sought on behalf of the respondents to file reply.
Reply be filed within two weeks.
6. Petitioner is directed to supply a copy of the petition in the office of Mr. B.S. Chhaba, learned Additional Advocate General.
7. We deem it proper to restrain the respondents from taking coercive action against the vendors who have applied for vending license, till further orders, however, this order would not apply to vendors who block public way.
8. List the matter on 17.05.2024.
