1. With the consent of both the parties, the writ present petition is disposed of in the following terms:

(i) The order passed by the learned Appellate Court dated 19.03.2025, is hereby quashed and set aside.

The respondent would be at liberty to move an application seeking withdrawal of his suit before the learned trial Court.

(ii) The respondent will also be at liberty to file a stay application in the subsequent suit which has been filed by him in pursuance of the order dated 03.01.2024.

(iii) If any such application is filed by the respondent, the learned trial Court is expected to decide it in accordance with law without being influenced by any of the observations or order passed by the Court.

2. All pending application(s), also stand disposed of.
