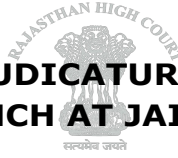

In compliance with the order dated 30.06.2026, Mr. Vishnu Dutt, ASI, Police Station Saipau, District Dholpur is present before this Court.

Learned Public Prosecutor has placed on record an application dated 29.04.2026 stating that the complainant-Kok Singh does not wish to pursue the FIR against the present petitioners.



The Investigating Officer has also submitted a factual report, which is taken on record. The report makes it clear that a negative final report has already been submitted in the matter.
