1. The present appeal has been filed assailing the order dated 26.02.2026, passed by learned Additional District Judge No.3, Alwar, whereby the temporary injunction application filed in the suit for specific performance has been rejected.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the amount in the agreement was paid through bank transactions. He further submits that the learned Trial Court, merely on the basis of readiness and willingness, rejected the temporary injunction application.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant further submits that the issue of readiness and willingness is one that should be decided after examining the evidence of the parties, and not at the stage of deciding the temporary injunction application.
4. Heard.
5. Let notices be issued to the defendant/respondent. Rule is made returnable within four weeks.
6. In the meantime, respondents are restrained from alienating or creating third party interest in the disputed property.



7. List this matter after four weeks.
