The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner being aggrieved by the order dated 03.11.2025 (Annexure-3), passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat (**PLA**), Jaipur Metropolitan – I, Jaipur, in case No.147/2024, vide which the complaint filed by the respondent has been allowed and the petitioner – Bank has been directed to pay compensation to the respondent – complainant on his complaint alleging that after the respondent deposited a cheque with the petitioner – Bank, the same was lost by the Bank and was thereafter returned with the remark 'funds insufficient'.

Mr. Shashank Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the bank has always been ready and willing to tender all possible assistance to the respondent. Thus, there was no occasion for PLA to pass the impugned order dated 03.11.2025 (Annexure-3).

Taking note of the above, issue notice to the sole respondent, returnable within four weeks. Notice be sent through registered post in addition to normal process.

Notice be given '*dasti*' to the learned counsel for the petitioner.
