1. The present civil misc. appeal has been filed assailing the order dated 17.03.2026, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Court No.11, Jaipur Metropolitan-I Headquarter Sanganer in Civil Misc. Case No.104/2025 (CIS No.322/2025), whereby the temporary injunction application of the plaintiff-appellant in suit for specific performance has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the consideration for the suit property was paid through RTGS to the defendant. He further submits that the learned Trial Court has merely, on the ground that some agreement to sell had been entered into by the plaintiff, rejected the temporary injunction application. He also submits that the same cannot be a valid ground for dismissal of the temporary injunction application in a suit for specific performance. He, therefore, prays that, during the pendency of the suit, the respondent be restrained from alienating the property in dispute.

3. Per contra, learned counsel for the respondent, appearing on caveat, opposes the prayer.
4. Heard.
5. This Court deems it appropriate to direct both the parties not to alienate the property in dispute during the pendency of the appeal.
6. Let the record of the temporary injunction application be summoned from the learned Trial Court.
7. List the matter for admission after the record is received.
