This civil first appeal has been filed under Section 96 of Civil Procedure Code, 1908 against the judgment and decree dated 12.03.2026 passed by Additional District Judge No.2, Bayana, Camp Rupwas, District Bharatpur, Rajasthan in Civil Suit no.15/2014, whereby, the learned trial Court dismissed the civil suit filed by the plaintiffs/appellants for partition of the property and for permanent injunction.
