1. Appeal comes up on second stay application, moved by the appellant in the light of liberty granted by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the order dated 11.05.2026 passed in Special Leave to Appeal (C) No.16735/2026.
2. The prayer made in second stay application by the appellant is to maintain status quo as to construction and possession of the suit property, in addition to the interim stay order dated 20.04.2026 passed by this Court on the stay application, restraining respondents from alienating the suit property.
3. Before hearing on second stay application, with the consent of counsel for both parties, this Court deems it just and proper to call for the status report of the suit property by appointing a Court Commissioner since the present status of suit property is not available on record.



4. In view of above, *Mr. Chandra Shekhar Sinha, Advocate (Enrollment No.R/1403/2016; Mobile No.+91-9602617420; Email ID- advcssinha@gmail.com)*, is appointed as Court Commissioner, who will inspect the suit property i.e. Plot No.R-2 measuring 1757.21 sq meter located in scheme "The Empreyan", Jaisinghpura, Bhankrota, Jaipur. The Court Commissioner shall visit the site on 05.08.2026 at 11:00 AM and he is at liberty to take the snaps and measurement of the suit property and if required, take assistance of concerned police station to maintain peace at site.
5. The Court Commissioner shall place on record the site inspection report along with a rough sketch map of site before this Court on the next date positively.
6. The fees of Court Commissioner is fixed as Rs.30,000/-, which shall be equally borne by both the parties.
7. Both parties or their respective representatives may remain present at the time of site inspection but shall not create hurdle to the proceedings of Court Commissioner.
8. List the matter on 06.08.2026 in supplementary list, as jointly agreed.
9. In the meanwhile, respondents are at liberty to file reply to the second stay application.
10. A copy of this order be provided forthwith today itself to the Court Commissioner under the seal and signature of Court Master.
