1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners being aggrieved by the action of the respondents in carrying out

development works which includes development of a cremation ground on the land of the petitioners being Khasra No.59, situated at Village Bhavpura, Patwar Halka Manota, Tehsil Jamwaramgarh, District Jaipur.

2. Mr. Kamal Kant Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that inadvertently, a portion of petitioner's Khasra No.59 was made a part of Khasra No.57, which is a Siwaichak land and on that pretext, development works including development of a cremation ground are being carried out by the respondents on Khasra No.57, which actually falls under Khasra No.59 of the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel submits that for correction of the maps, an application under Sections 131, 132 and 136 of the Rajasthan Land Revenue Act, 1956 has already been filed by the petitioners, which is pending before the Sub-Divisional Officer (**SDO**), Tehsil Jamwaramgarh, District Jaipur, and even an interim order dated 22.05.2025 has been passed by the SDO directing the parties to maintain status quo *qua* Khasra No. 57, 59 and 80.

4. Learned counsel further submits that the said interim order is still in force, however, solely on the premise that Gram Panchayat Bhavpura was not arrayed as a party in the said application before the SDO, respondent No.4 is proceeding ahead with the development works on the disputed land including construction of a cremation ground.

5. Learned counsel also submits that Gram Panchayat Bhavpura has filed an application seeking impleadment in the application filed by the petitioners, however despite the same, it is proceeding ahead with the said works.

- 6.** Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents No.1 to 4, both by ordinary process as well as the registered post.
- 7.** Notices be given *dasti* as well to the learned counsel for the petitioners.
- 8.** Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned AGC, puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.
- 9.** Hence, service *qua* respondents No.1 to 3 stands complete. Notice be filed only for respondent No.4.
- 10.** Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to serve a copy of the writ petition in the Office of Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned AGC, within three days from today.
- 11.** List the matter on 12.05.2026.
- 12.** Till the next date, respondents are directed to maintain status quo *qua* the land in question being Khasra No.57, 59 and 80, situated at Village Bhavpura, Patwar Halka Manota, Tehsil Jamwaramgarh, District Jaipur.
