1. Heard on interim stay application.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the issue raised in the present writ petition is squarely covered by order dated 01.04.2026 passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in **Amit Kumar Sen & Ors. v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.: SBCW No. 5912/2026.**
3. The main contention of the petitioners in the present writ petition is that the present petitioners are of Guest Faculty and they cannot be replaced by another set of Guest Faculty.
4. Considering the aforesaid order passed in **Amit Kumar Sen (supra)** and the contentions raised by the petitioners, the respondents are directed to continue the petitioners as a Guest Faculty as long as they felt their need without replacing them with a new set of Guest Faculty.
